Four very brave staff put their baking skills to the test for the residents of Kinning Park to judge!

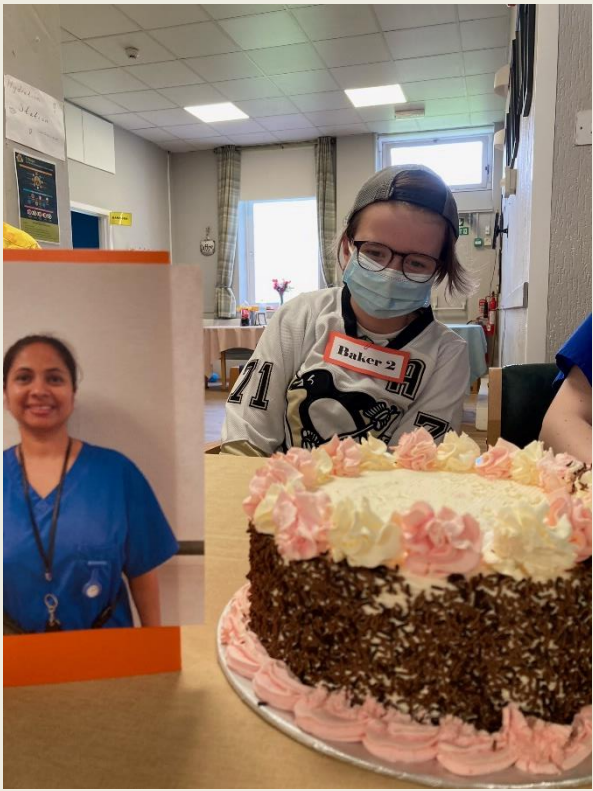
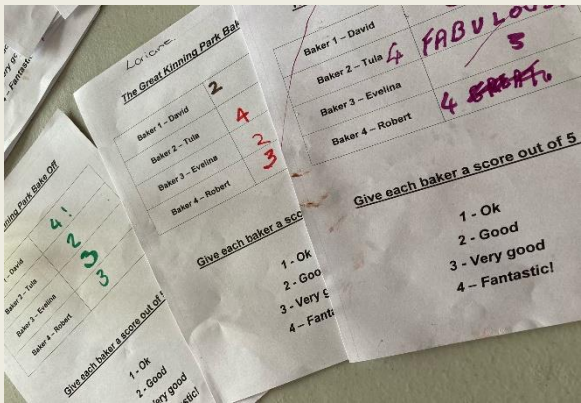
