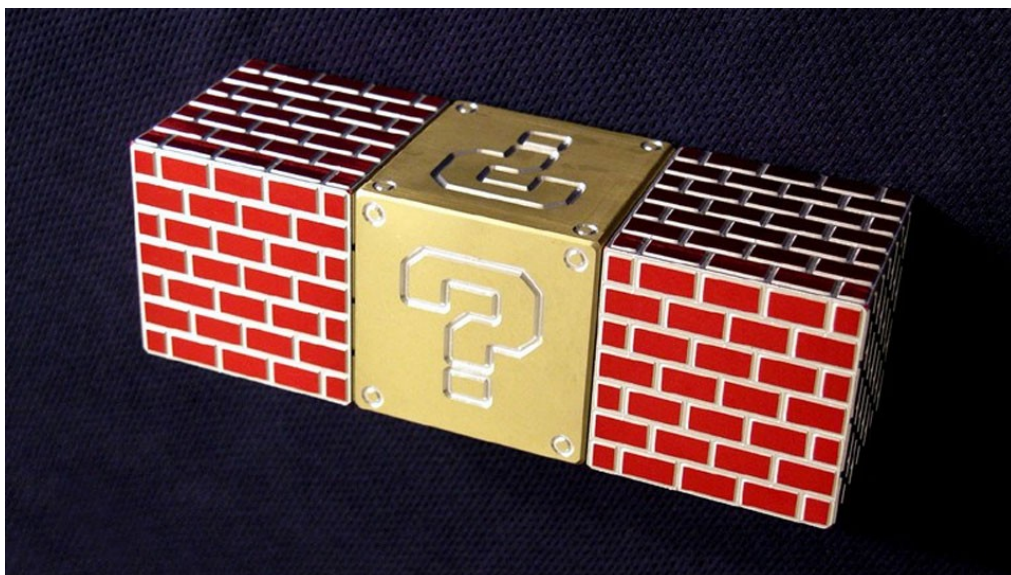
Please welcome onboard our lovely new Activity Coordinator, Abbey McTague who is looking forward to starting her new job on the 29th June 2015.
