Abbey will be working alongside Ashley for the month of July.

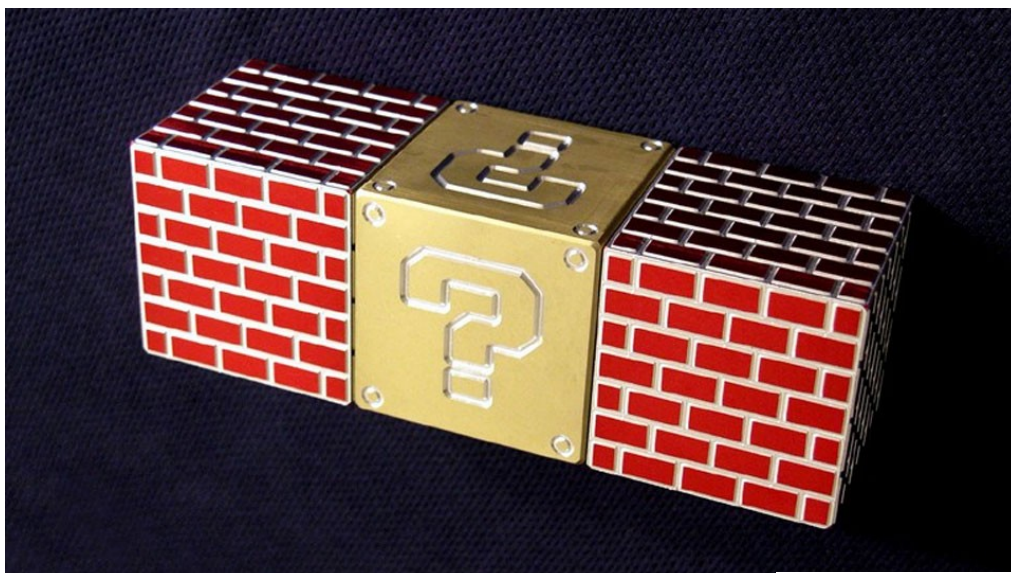
Abbey is an experienced Coordinator and will bring lots of new ideas to the home .
