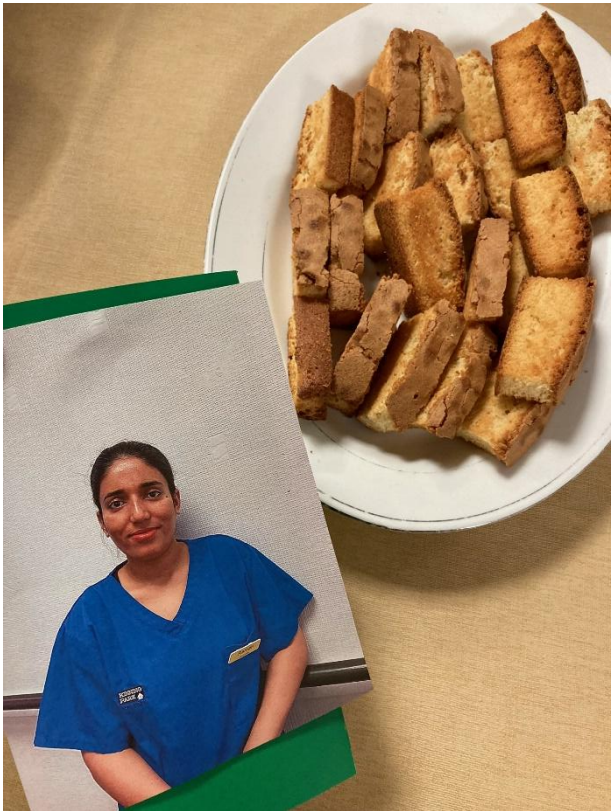

After the success of the first summer Bake Off, we thought we'd do it again.

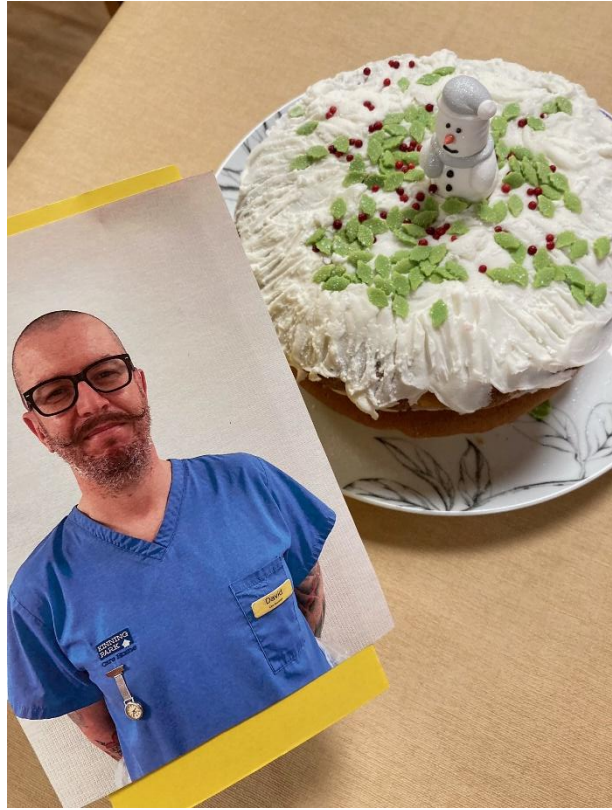
(Just another excuse to eat cake really!)

Well done to the winner Emellia!!! (Who may or may not have had help from her flatmates..shhhh)

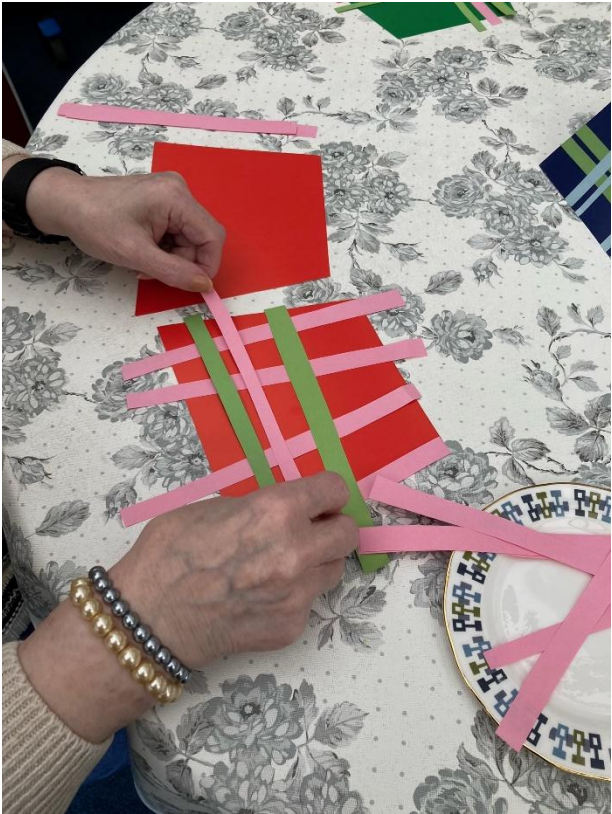

Pass the Haggis!

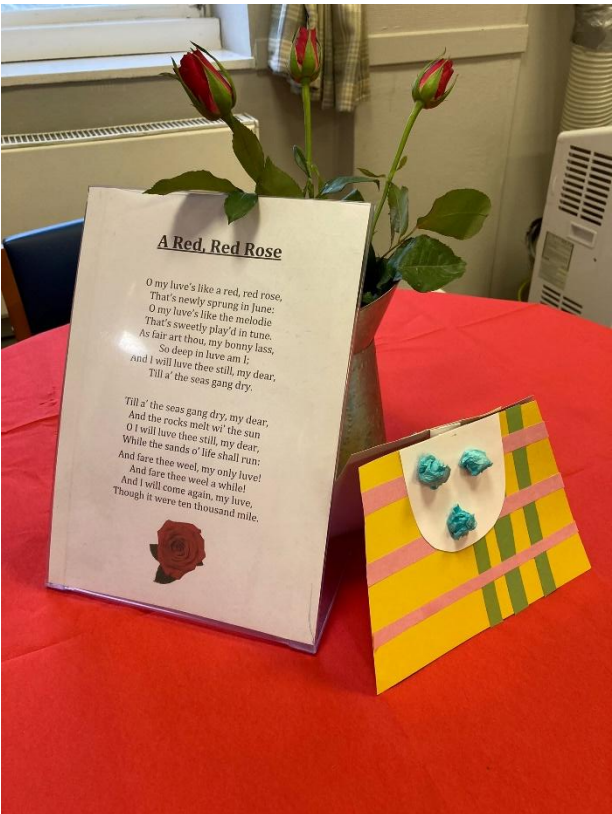
CRAFTING AND A CUPPA

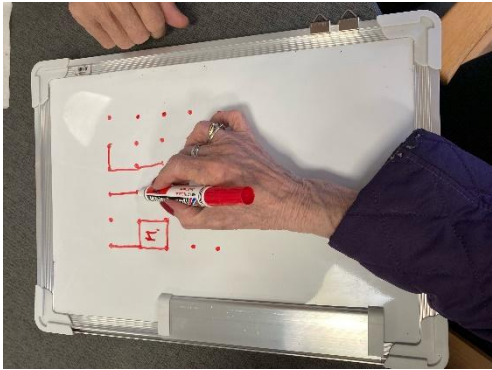
